## Alive Community Church - Annual Report for Year Ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2010 SHORT WRITE UP ON MAJOR EVENTS

#### Church Camp:

For Annual Church Camp in Dec'10, it was conducted from  $19^{\rm th}$  to  $22^{\rm nd}$  December 2010 at Corus Hotel in Kuala Lumpur. We had Rev John Arcovio, Bro Keith McCann and Elizabeth McCann as guest speakers. For Dec'10 camp, we had about 96 participants from Singapore joined by others from churches in Malaysia.

#### Youth & Sports Ministries:

Sports Ministry is a subgroup of our Youth and Young Adult Ministry, reaching out to youths and young adults who come from the sports arena. Both ministries are run by a team of committed young adult leaders with the guidance of a few adult helpers. These groups meet for their respective cell fortnightly on weekday nights and Sunday mornings for Praise & Worship, Bible Study and Body life ministry. Various discipleship processes e.g. foundation studies and home bible studies are conducted on different days throughout the week. The ministries organize various outreach events on top of their cell meetings e.g. bible studies, outings, sports and games activities etc.

#### Leaders Meetings

Leaders and Assistant leaders come from all ministries - Youth Ministry, Sports Ministry, Sunday School Ministry, Music & Sound ministry, Epaphras ministry, Ushering ministry, Chinese ministry met for regular discussion and updates on the progress of the various ministries.

#### Prayer Ministry:

The Epaphras ministry was set up at the beginning of 2005 to cater to the needs of members who need prayer and ministry. Besides embarking on intense prayer for church members in need, running pre-service prayer on Sundays, the ministry also held a month of prayers and fasting in November for the church camp in December 2010.

#### Missions:

A group of 7 went to Jakarta for a weekend mission trip in August 2010. The group managed to visit children at the outskirts of Jakarta and ran activities and games with the children there.

For the December Philippines mission trip, Pastor Mathews and Bro John were the main guest speaker in Philippines Mission trip.

Apart from mission trips, the church supported church planting works in Sabah and Bagiuo Evangelistic Academy of Ministries in the Philippines.

#### Special Speakers:

We had a good number of guest speakers from USA and Canada who ministered to the church. These guest speakers include Rev. #### Alive Community Network:

Church members continued to support the initiatives of Alive Community Network, the welfare organization affiliated with the church.

# REVIEW OF FINANCIAL STATE AND EXPLANATION FOR MAJOR FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS

We have a total of about \$481,148 free will offerings and donations from our members this year.

The Church spent about \$168,152 on the rental of our worship and training premises this year.

We gave about \$29,778 in missions support to various works and projects in countries like Philippines, West Malaysia and Sabah.

We invited about 8 overseas speakers this year to speak and teach on special events and seminars. We spent about \$22,321 on their airfares, accommodation, love offerings and other expenses.

#### FUTURE PLANS AND COMMITMENTS

The church is also looking towards hiring a associate pastor to further strengthen its pastoral and pulpit ministries. We are also planning to further help our affiliated VWO in its various initiatives to help the community.
