Proclaim who God is

Acts 17:22-23 ²² Then Paul stood in the midst of the Areopagus and said, “Men of Athens, I perceive that in all things you are very religious; ²³ for as I was passing through and considering the objects of your worship, I even found an altar with this inscription:

- TO THE UNKNOWN GOD.

Therefore, the One whom you worship without knowing, Him I proclaim to you:

Proclaim the gospel (Good news)

Mark 16:15 And he said to them, “Go into all the world and **proclaim** the gospel to the whole creation.

What is the gospel (Good news)?

1 Corinthian 15:1-4 Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, ² by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.³ For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that **Christ died for our sins** according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that **He was buried**, and that **He rose again** the third day according to the Scriptures,

Proclaim the Kingdom of God

Luke 9:1-2 ¹ He summoned the Twelve and gave them power and authority over all demons and to cure diseases, and he sent them to **proclaim the kingdom of God** and to heal.

Luke 4:18-19 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me,
Because He has anointed Me
To preach the gospel to the poor;
He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,
To **proclaim liberty to the captives**
And **recovery of sight to the blind,**
To set at liberty those who are oppressed;
¹⁹ To **proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.**"

Proclaim the whole counsel of God

Acts 20: 25-27 And now, behold, I know that all of you among whom I have gone about proclaiming the kingdom will see my face no more. Therefore I testify to you in this day that I *am* innocent of the blood of all. For I did not shrink back from proclaiming to you the whole counsel of God.

Proclaim what God has done for you

Mark 5:19-20 But Jesus would not allow him. “Go home to your own people,” He said, “and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and what mercy He has shown you.” So the man went away and began to **proclaim** throughout the Decapolis how much Jesus had done for him. And everyone was amazed.

Proclaim the new covenant through Jesus death

1 Corinthians 11:23-26 For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus, on the night he was handed over, took bread, ²⁴ and, after he had given thanks, broke it and said, "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." ²⁵ In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." ²⁶ For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you **proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes.**

I must proclaim this Message

1 Corinthians 9:16-18 If I **proclaim the Message**, it's not to get something out of it for myself. **I'm compelled to do it, and doomed if I don't!** If this was my own idea of just another way to make a living, I'd expect some pay. But since it's not my idea but something solemnly entrusted to me, why would I expect to get paid? So am I getting anything out of it? Yes, as a matter of fact: **the pleasure of proclaiming the Message** at no cost to you. You don't even have to pay my expenses!

Proclaim the message everywhere

2 Corinthians 10:15-16 But we have the hope that as your faith increases, our area of ministry will be greatly enlarged, ¹⁶ so that we may **proclaim the good news to the regions beyond you**, not boasting about what has already been done in someone else's area of ministry.

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is God's power for salvation to everyone who believes, first to the Jew, and also to the Greek.

How you can be Actively Proclaiming?

- Put a bible verse/statement on your desk/social media profile etc
- Share a video about why it makes sense to believe in God
- Write out your personal testimony and share it
- Read out a passage of Scripture to someone
- Do a kind deed and when someone asks, tell them you did it because God gave you strength
- Share your experience of receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit
- Share to someone why you are not fearful of the nCoV virus
- Share to someone that you like coming to church
